

UPHILL SKINNING POLICY

Guests at Bear Creek Mountain Resort are permitted to ascend uphill/skin subject to the following conditions.

- 1. Guest must have a valid lift pass or season pass in their possession.
- 2. Ascending uphill or skinning is only permitted on Monday through Thursday from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM during non-holiday hours.
- 3. Uphill ascending or skinning is only permitted during operational hours of Bear Creek Mountain Resort.
- 4. Ascending or skinning must be done to the sides of any trail where you are visible to skiers/boarders from above. The equipment must be worn for ascending, NO Hiking or Snowshoeing.
- 5. No pets are permitted while skinning or at any time on Bear Creek Mountain Resort property.
- 6. Backpacks are permitted while skinning but NO backpacking of children.
- 7. The following is the only equipment permitted and it must have an attached retention device or ski brakes: Telemark Skis

Alpine touring skis - Randonne

Split Board

8. Ascending/Skinning is **NOT** permitted on the following trails:

Sasquatch

Extreme

Grizzly

Any Terrain Park

Any Closed Trail

- 9. All uphill participants are requested to check in at the ski patrol room prior to entering the skiable terrain.
- 10. Bear Creek Mountain Resort reserves the right to restrict ascending/skinning at any time due to weather, slope conditions, or any other circumstance that may affect the safety of our guests. Check with Ski Patrol prior to your arrival.
